International Participation of 13 countries - Austria, Bulgaria, Montenegro, Croatia, Italy, Germany, Poland, Russia, Slovakia, Estonia, Lithuania, Latvia, Czech Rep.

Sports Categories and Sports - The games were divided into three categories:

- **“Masters“** for high-performance athletes with health classification. They competed in the following sports – Athletics, Boccia, Swimming, Table Tennis and Wheelchair Tennis.
- **“Open“** for athletes without health classification. They competed in Athletics, Boccia, Swimming and Table Tennis. The competitions were held in compliance with the relevant international rules, which, however, were applied less strictly. This category gives a chance to handicapped children who have only begun with a sport or only practising recreational sports to meet in a “big competition” with their athletic models.
- **“Mixed“** for mixed teams of disabled and non-disabled athletes. They competed in Chess, Handbike and Wheelchair Streetball. Included also a special programme of joint activities of persons with disability and non-disability athletes. This category is one of the parts of the „integration” mission of the games.
