Who can apply?

Funding is available for a national organization which is responsible for CP Football.

You will need to have a written constitution or governing document which should contain a clear statement that your organization is the national sport governing body for CP Football. Your membership should be open to all sections of the community.

If your organisation is part of a larger organization (such as a National Paralympic Committee, a national disability sports organization or the national Football Association) you will need the support of that organisation, which must accept overall responsibility for the grant.

We are looking for countries which have already started to develop football program for athletes with a disability, including athletes with cerebral palsy, mild traumatic brain injuries, having experienced a stroke or other related neurological conditions.

Requirements

Applications must be submitted by November 1st one year prior to completion of the activity. Application submitted after November 1st will be discussed in the IFCPF board

Decision

IFCPF Board will make a decision which applications are successful by February 1st of the following year.

IFCPF Board will take a decision for applications received after November 1st as soon as possible after the application has been received.

It is an expectation of IFCPF that any funding granted would be spent in accordance with the approved project within a year of the grant being awarded.

Member countries have a preference when assessing the application. Nonmember countries have to become a member. IFCPF provides a courtesy membership for € 100 for the first two years. This amount of € 200 will be deducted from the grant.

Applicants who invite neighboring countries have a greater chance of being successful in their application. IFCPF is using the United Nation Geoscheme.

Our strategic outcomes

Our mission is to get more people playing CP Football more often and all applications should tell us how they will help deliver our strategic outcomes:

- More people playing CP Football nationally
- Regular training for CP Football
- A youth program
- A commitment to develop female players

Your benefits:

The grantee will receive an initial award of 50% of the total funding amount at the beginning of the project period. Within one month of the completion of the final activity the National Federation or NPC is required to submit an evaluation form, photos and a project development plan for the next two years to the IFCPF Secretariat. If IFCPF finds the development plan to be sufficient in content the outstanding 50% of the total grant award will be released.

IFCPF course instructors will deliver the workshop. The costs relating to the accommodation including meals of the workshop's course instructors is the responsibility of the organizing National Federation or NPC. The costs relating to the international travel of the IFCPF course instructors is the responsibility of IFCPF, with all other internal transportation requirements being funded and organized by the host National Federation or NPC. The National Federation or NPC are responsible for all other costs relating to the successful delivery of the workshop(s).

Your obligations:

- Initial application
- Budget for course
- A two year action plan for development of CP Football to be delivered due one month after completion of the course
- An evaluation report due one month after completion of the course
- Provision of the necessary tools for course delivery
 - Local transportation for course instructors
 - Accommodation for course instructors (including meals)
 - Classroom with a projector, WiFi and whiteboard or flipcharts
 - Field of Play
 - CP Players (if possible)
 - Football equipment (balls, goals, cones, markers, bibs)
